southeasterly across the S.E. 1/4 of the same, and again running
southeasterly across the S.W. 1/4 of Section 8. To a point where
the course of the Stream crosses the Crown Lake and Shepard Road
near the line between sections 8 and the N.W. 1/4 of Section 17.
