AUDITOR'S NOTICE OF PENDING OF PETITION.

Whereas, the owners of certain lands in the town of Grow of said Anoka county, upon the petition of Peter Brant, Andrew Peterson, Tosten Isakson, Adolph Buehotz, Joseph Herrmann, John Okerlund, bearing date the 10th day of September, 1892, and on file in my office, praying for the establishment of a public ditch along the route proposed therein.

Now, therefore, notice is hereby given of the pendency of said petition, and that the same will be heard and determined before the said Board of County Commissioners, at their meeting in special session at the Court House, in the city of Anoka, on the 11th day of March, 1893, at 10 o'clock a. m.

The place of commencement of said ditch at its source is as follows: Commencing in the sw¹/₄ of section 13, town. 32, range 24, thence easterly through said sw¹/₄, southerly through w¹/₂ of se¹/₄ of said section 13, through ne¹/₄ of section 24, through sw¹/₄ of section 24, through s¹/₂ of se¹/₄, section 28, through ne¹/₄ of section 26, all in town. 32, range 24.
