Notice is hereby given, that, on the 6th day of May, 1893, at 11 o'clock a. m., at the County Auditor's Office in the City of Anoka, County of Anoka and State of Minnesota, I will sell the jobs of digging and constructing the Ditch No. 20 of Anoka County, established by the Board of County Commissioners of Anoka County, State of Minnesota, by their order bearing date March 11th, 1893, viz.: In sections of 100 feet each, of said sections to be known and numbered by stakes, as shown by the report of the viewers in said matter, commencing at the one including the outlet, and from thence, successively, up stream to the one including the source: the place of commencement of said Ditch is as follows: In the ne<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of nw<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Sec. 13, Town 32, Range 24; th. easterly into the w<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> se<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of said Sec. 13; and southerly thro' said w<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> se<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of said Sec. 13; and southerly thro' w<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> ne<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Sec. 24; th. south-westerly thro' sw<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of said Sec. 24; thro' se<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> se<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, Sec. 23; thence southerly thro' w<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> of ne<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Sec. 26; through se<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> ne<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of said Sec. 26 into the ne<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of se<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of said Sec. 26 to connect with Coon Creek (so called) in said ne<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> se<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of said Sec. 26 as its outlet all in Town 32, Range 24, to the lowest responsible bidder or bidders, said work to be completed within the time required, and in the manner specified, in said viewer's report. And no bid will be entertained which exceeds more than thirty (30) per cent over and above the estimated cost of the construction, in any case, as stated in the said order; and the successful bidder will be required to give a satisfactory bond, with two freehold securities, for the faithful performance and fulfillment of his contract, and to pay all damages that may accrue by reason of his failure to complete the job within the time required in the contract.
