or assigns, for which payments, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves,  
our heirs, executors and administrators, firmly by these presents.

Sealed with our seals and dated the tenth day of June, one thousand nine  
hundred and fourteen (1914).

THE CONDITION OF THE ABOVE OBLIGATION IS SUCH, That whereas the above  
bounden Willie Erickson and others have filed a petition with the County  
Auditor of Anoka County, State of Minnesota, to the County Board thereof,  
praying for the repair of County Ditch Number Twenty (20) of said County;

Now, if the said Willie Erickson, A. C. Boyd  
W. F. Wehlitz and J. C. Morgan shall pay all  
expenses, in case the said county Board and the court in case of an appeal  
according to law, shall fail to order said proposed repairs, then the above  
obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
