The Condition of the Above Obligation is Such, That whereas the above bounden Peter Brant Andrew Peterson, Gustav Erikson Adolph Bucholtz, Joseph Hermann and John Oberlund have filed a petition with the County Auditor of Anoka County, State of Minnesota, praying for the establishment and construction of a public Ditch

along the following described route: Commencing in the S.W. 1/4 of Section 13, Town 32 Range 24, thence southerly through said S.W. 1/4 of section 13, Easterly through N. 1/2 S.E. 1/4 of said sec. 13, thence southerly through N.E. 1/4 sec. 24, S.W. 1/2 S.E. 1/4 sec. 24, westerly through S.W. 1/4 sec. 24, southerly through E. 1/2 N.E. 1/4 sec. 26, and S.E. 1/4 of sec. 26, all in Township 32, Range 24, and terminating at Coon Creek so called in sec. 26

Now, if the said Peter Brant Andrew Peterson, Gustav Erikson Adolph Bucholtz, Joseph Hermann and John Oberlund

shall pay all expenses, in case the Board of County Commissioners of said County shall fail to establish said proposed Ditch then the above obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
