of Anoka County party of the first part, and E. W. Putnam
County Auditor of the County of Anoka State of Minnesota, in behalf
of Anoka County, Minnesota, WITNESSETH:

Therefore, The Board of County Commissioners of the County of Anoka
State of Minnesota, did establish and order to be constructed a certain Ditch
designated as No. 21 which number has been given to said Ditch
by the County Auditor

by their order, bearing date the 3rd day of January 1884,
and according to the report of the viewers thereof, all of which
are on file in the office of the said County Auditor:

And therefore, At a public sale of the jobs of digging and constructing the entire work in
linear sections of 100 feet each, each of which sections is marked and known and numbered by the
stake set by said viewers at the foot of each of said sections, as shown by the viewers' report, com-
mencing at the one including the outlet, and thence, in succession, to the one including the source,
held March 10 1884, the said E. W. Putnam
County Auditor as aforesaid, did duly sell to the said Hans Hanson
he being the ~~highest~~ ^{lowest} and best responsible bidder, the job of digging and constructing the following
