Notice is hereby given, that, on the 10th day of March

1884, at 11 o'clock A. M., at the County Auditor's office in the City of Duluth County of Duluth and State of Minnesota

I will sell the jobs of digging and constructing the Ditch No. 21 of Duluth

County, established by the Board of County Commissioners of Duluth County,

State of Minnesota, by their order bearing date January 3rd 1884, viz.:

In sections of 100 feet each, each of said sections to be known and numbered by stakes, as shown by the report of the viewers in said matter, commencing at the one including the outlet, and from thence, successively, up stream to the one including the source Said Ditch

commencing at the north west corner of the 8.1/4 of T. 8. N. 1/4 of R. 6. E. 1/4 of Sec. 6 in Township 32 in Range 23 thence running on a North westerly course through said sec. 6 to the East line of sec. 1 in Township 32 and Range 24 in the said County of Duluth, thence westerly through the North half of said sec. one (1) to the East line of sec. 2 in said Township 32 and Range 24 thence South westerly through said sec. 2 to a point on the west line of sec. 1 sec. 2 where Blanks Brook (so called), crosses said sec. line, thence down Blanks Brook in a North westerly & North easterly course through the 8.3/4 of Sec. 3 Township 32 and Range 24 and terminating at station 235 in Blanks Brook (so called), to the N. 3/4 of Sec. 3 Township 32 Range 24 as its outlet.

to the lowest responsible bidder or bidders, said work to be completed within the time required, and in the manner specified, in said viewer's report. And no bid will be entertained which exceeds more than thirty (30) per cent over and above the estimated cost of the construction, in any case, as stated in the said order; and the successful bidder will be required to give a satisfactory bond, with two freehold securities, for the faithful performance and fulfillment of his contract, and to pay all damages that may accrue by reason of his failure to complete the job within the time required in the contract.
