PETITION FOR PUBLIC DITCH.

To the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Shaska
State of Minnesota:

The undersigned land owners, whose lands will be liable to be affected by, or assessed for, the expense of the construction of the Ditch will be conducive to the hereinafter described, would respectfully represent that the public health, convenience and welfare require the establishment and construction of said Ditch along the following described route in the Town of Julie's health convenience and places, and the same within said County of Shaska to wit: Commencing at utility, and are the undersigned hereby petition and regard the said Board of County Commissioners to cause to be contracted a Ditch along the following described route, in the corner of Rain Lake and Grapes in that said County of Minn. Co. and commencing at the North west corner of the South West Quarter of the 10th East Quarter (1st Mer) of Section six (6) in Township Thirty Two (32) in Range Twenty Three (23); thence running in a north westerly course through said Section Six (6) to the East line of the One (1) in Township Thirty Two (32) and Range Twenty Four (24) in the said County of Shaska; and terminating at thence westerly through the North half by and see line (11) to the East line of the East (23) in said Township Thirty Two (32) and Range Twenty Four (24); thence south westerly as its outlet shall said Sec. Ten (2) to a point on the West line of said Sec. Ten (2) where the Clark's Ditch, to which name and see title; thence down Clark's Ditch via North westerly course through the Sec One Three (3) in Township Thirty Two (32) and Range Twenty Four (24) and terminating at the point where said Clark's Ditch crosses the North line of the said East and West (24) of said Sec. Three (3) as its outlet.
