Gatherers, The Board of County Commissioners of the County of Dutcher  
 State of Minnesota, did establish and order to be constructed a certain Ditch  
 designated as No. 22 which number has been given to said Ditch  
 by the County Auditor

by their order, bearing date the 3rd day of March, 1894,

And Gatherers, At a public sale of the jobs of digging and constructing the entire work in
