Ross made motion that the applications for homestead be granted and the applications for correction of assessed valuations be approved according to the recommendations of the County Assessor, and sent to the State Commissioner of Taxation for final approval. Fields seconded the motion, all voting "yes". Motion declared adopted.

Commissioner Ross offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Anoka County, Minnesota, has prepared a list designated as Appraisal List No. 50 and dated June 4, 1962, of lands forfeited to the State of Minnesota pursuant to Minnesota Statutes annotated, Chapter 282, and has determined that it is advisable to sell said lands and has determined the appraised value thereof;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That each parcel shown on said Appraisal List No. 50 be appraised for the amount set opposite the description thereof and that the County Auditor is hereby directed to offer each parcel to the highest bidder but for not less than the appraised value at a public sale commencing at 10:00 A.M., July 18, 1962. Thereafter, any remaining parcels shall be sold at private sale for not less than the appraised value as determined in said Appraisal List No. 50. All sales shall be for cash, subject to existing leases, if any; to easements obtained by any governmental subdivision or agency thereof for any public purposes; to restrictions appearing of record at the time of the tax-judgment sale; to all existing laws and ordinances; and to the condition that the appraised value does not represent a basis for future taxes.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this resolution and said Appraisal List No. 50 be filed with the County Auditor and that notice be given in accordance with the statute therefor provided, that a public sale will be held on the 18th day of July, 1962, at 10:00 A. M., in the Court House, in the City of Anoka, in the County of Anoka and State of Minnesota.

Gaslin seconded the motion to adopt the resolution and upon roll call vote Commissioners Fields, Gaslin, Ross and Chairman Korhala voted "yes". Fred C. Knott absent. No one voted "no". Resolution declared adopted.

Lee Robinson requested permission to make some repairs to County Ditch No. 10, stating that he would make the repairs if the county would furnish the culvert.

Fields made motion that the request of Lee Robinson to make repairs to County Ditch #10 at his own expense and that the County furnish a culvert, be approved, subject to the final approval of County Engineer Lundholm, and Commissioner Ross. Gaslin seconded the motion, all voting "yes". Motion declared adopted.

DITCH NUMBER 22

County Board Meeting - October 22, 1951 - Page 2914

Mr. Robinson representing Robinson Farms, Section five and six, Centerville Twp., appeared before the Board asking an appropriation to complete ditch from East Main Street, stating that the project if completed would be of great benefit to East Main Street by lowering water levels in the side ditches. Ittner made motion to refer this request to Chief Highway Engineer, and to the County Attorney, to determine if this proposed off-take ditch would lower the water levels in the side ditches thereby benefitting the subgrade of East Main Street, to the extent that the proposed expenditures would be justified, motion seconded by Wilberg. Motion carried.

County Board Meeting - November 5, 1951 - Page 2918

Chief Highway Engineer reported that the request by Robinson Farm for an appropriation for Ditch Correction was not warranted.

County Board Meeting - October 11, 1960 - Page 121

Stinson made motion that the County upon recommendation of the County Engineer share in the costs of repair to the County Ditch through the Robinson Farm in Section 7, Twp. 31, Range 22 to the extent of 5% of the cost of the repairs to that portion. Knodt seconded the motion, all voting "yes". Motion declared adopted.

Roland Anderson has aerial photos of Section 5, 6 and 7 taken in 1953 and again in 1960 which will show that the main course of ditch has been changed.

We find from the minutes no specific authorization for this alteration.
