SALE OF DITCHING JOBS.

Notice is hereby given, That, on the 3^d day of May

1884, at 11 o'clock A. M., at the County Auditor's Office in the City
of Shuika, County of Shuika and State of Minnesota

I will sell the jobs of digging and constructing the Ditch No. 29 of Shuika

County, established by the Board of County Commissioners of Shuika County,

State of Minnesota, by their order bearing date March 3^d 1884, viz.:

In sections of 100 feet each, each of said sections to be known and numbered by stakes, as shown by the report of the viewers in said matter, commencing at the one including the outlet, and from thence, successively, up stream to the one including the source. Commencing at the North East corner of the North West Quarter of the North West Quarter of Section Number Thirty-two (32) and Township (32) Thirty-two, and Range Twenty-two (22). Thence southerly across said Section No. Thirty-two (32) to Section No. Five (5) in Township Thirty-one (31) and Range Twenty-two (22). Thence southerly and westerly across said Section Five (5) to Section Six (6) in said Township and Range. Thence westerly and southerly across said Section Six (6) to Section Seven (7) in said Township and Range. Thence southerly across said Section Seven (7) until it intersects the County Ditch running across said Section Seven (7) and known as Ditch No. Ten (10) and thence terminating at its outlet;

to the lowest responsible bidder or bidders, said work to be completed within the time required, and in the manner specified, in said viewer's report. And no bid will be entertained which exceeds more than thirty (30) per cent over and above the estimated cost of the construction, in any case, as stated in the said order; and the successful bidder will be required to give a satisfactory bond, with two freehold securities, for the faithful performance and fulfillment of his contract, and to pay all damages that may accrue by reason of his failure to complete the job within the time required in the contract. The said order and estimates and profile are on file, and may be seen at my office.
