number Thirty-Two (32) in Township number Thirty-Nine and Range
number Twenty-Three (23); thence easterly across said section, thence
No. 32 to Section number Four (4), in Township number Thirty-one (31)
and terminating at said Range number Twenty-Three (23); thence southward
and easterly across said Section number 4 to Section number Six (6)
in said Town of Cobourg; thence westerly across said
