# PETITION FOR PUBLIC DITCH.

To the Board of County Commissioners of the County of \_\_\_\_\_

The undersigned land owners, whose lands will be liable to be affected by, or assessed for, the expense of the construction of the Ditch

hereinafter described, would respectfully represent that the ~~public health, convenience and welfare~~ require the establishment and construction of a public Ditch ~~with~~ and ~~where~~ along the following described route in the Town of S. the public health, convenience and welfare ~~will~~ be ~~to wit~~ Commencing at W. of hwy 161 and ending at the underground hwy 161 and regarding the said Board of County Commissioners to cause to be constructed a Ditch along the following described route in the Town of Bellevue and containing of acres to wit: Commencing at the North East corner of the North West Quarter (N.W. 1/4) of the South West Quarter (S.W. 1/4) of Section number Thirty Two (32) in Township number Thirty, Range number Twenty Two (22), then easterly across said Section number Twenty Two (22) to Section number Forty (40) and thence southerly and westerly across said Section number Forty (40) and Section number Forty Six (46) as the outlet Section number Six (6) & Section number Seven (7) in and from the Range, then southerly across said Section number Seven (7) & the North East (N.E.) corner of the South West Quarter (S.W. 1/4) of the South East Quarter (S.E. 1/4) of said Section number Seven (7), thence southerly until it intersects the Boundary with running across said Section (7) & thence so with the Ditch and then terminating as follows:

And your petitioners pray that you will proceed to establish such Ditch and cause the same to be constructed as provided by

Chapter 97 General Laws of Minnesota, 1887.
