corner of the NW 1/4, Sec. 32, Town 32, Range 22, there
westly course and across to sec. 5 in Town 31 and
Range 22; th. southerly and westerly course and sec.
5 to Section 6 in said Town and Range; th. westerly
and southerly course and sec. 6 to rd. 7 in said
Town and Range; th. southerly course and very to the
NE. corner of the SW 1/4, Sec. 37 said sec. 7 thence
southerly until it intersects the County Ditch running
across said sec. 7 and thence as filed here and then of
terminating as the outlet.
