Whereas, the owners of certain lands in the towns of Anoka, Grow and Ham Lake of said Anoka county, upon the petition of C. D. Tutthill, Peter Olson, John P. Swanson, Erick Johnson, Jules Boywell, Peter Swanson, Andrew Olson and A. Hawkins bearing date the 15th day of June, 1894, and on file in my office, praying for the establishment of a public ditch along the route proposed therein.

Now, therefore, notice is hereby given of the pendency of said petition, and that the same will be heard and determined before the said Board of County Commissioners, at their meeting, in regular session at the court house, in the city of Anoka, on the 8th day of January, 1895, at 10 o'clock a. m.

The place of commencement of said ditch at its source is as follows: Commencing at or near the center of the $\text{se}\frac{1}{4}$ of $\text{re}\frac{1}{2}$ of section 1, town 31, range 24; thence northwesterly through the $\text{ne}\frac{1}{4}$ of said section 1, to the $\text{se}\frac{1}{4}$ of section 36, town 32, range 24; thence northeasterly through the $\text{se}\frac{1}{4}$ of said section 36, into section 31, town 32, range 23; thence in a northerly course through the west $\frac{1}{2}$ of said section 31, into the $\text{sw}\frac{1}{4}$ of $\text{sw}\frac{1}{4}$ of section 30, town 32, range 23.

The names of the persons through whose lands the proposed ditch passes are as follows: Edward Brooks, Greenwald & Niles, Elizabeth L. Bradley, G. W. Murrell, A. Hawkins, Foster R. Clement.

The place of termination of said ditch at its outlet is as follows: Terminating at a point in Coon Creek (so called) in the $\text{sw}\frac{1}{4}$ of $\text{sw}\frac{1}{4}$ of said section 30, 40 rods east of the west line of said $\text{sw}\frac{1}{4}$ of $\text{sw}\frac{1}{4}$ of said section 30, to be known as Ditch No. 23.
