PETITION FOR PUBLIC DITCH.

To the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Shoeka
State of Minnesota:

The undersigned land owners, whose lands will be liable to be affected by, or assessed for, the expense of the construction of the Ditch hereinafter described, would respectfully represent that ~~the public health, convenience and welfare~~ require the establishment and construction of ~~a~~ said Ditch will be conducive ~~to the public~~ among the following described route in the Town of Health, convenience and welfare and the same will be of public ~~in said County of Hennepin and utility, and~~ to wit: Commencing at one the undesignated hereby location and request the said Board of County Commissioners ~~to cause the same to be constructed~~ advised along the following described route in the Town of Shoeka ~~and~~ Shoeka ~~and~~ beginning at a corner near the center of the 8 1/4 of Section 1, Town 31 Range 24, thence Northward through the 8 1/4 of Section 1, Town 31 Range 24, the 8 1/4 of Section 36, Town 32 Range 24, thence Northward through the 8 1/4 of Section 31, Range 23, thence in a Northward course through the West 1/2 of said Section 31 into the 8 N 1/4 of 8 N 1/4 of ~~and terminating at~~ Section 30, Town 32 Range 23 and terminating at a point in Section 30 (referred to in the 8 N 1/4 of 8 N 1/4 of said Section 30, 40 rods east of the west line of said 8 N 1/4 of 8 N 1/4 of said Section 30, as its outlet.
