

Sale of Ditching Jobs.

(First Publication Feb. 13, 1895.)

Notice is hereby given, That, on the 9th day of March, 1895, at 11 o'clock a. m., at the County Auditor's office in the City of Anoka, County of Anoka and State of Minnesota, I will sell the jobs of ditching and constructing the Ditch No. 2 of Anoka County, established by the Board of County Commissioners of Anoka County, State of Minnesota, by their order bearing date January 9th, 1895, viz.: In sections of 160 feet each, each of said sections to be known and numbered by stakes, as shown by the report of the viewers in said matter, commencing at the one including the outlet, and from thence, successively, up stream to the one including the source, (commencing at or near the center of the sec. 2, of north of Section 1, Town 31, Range 24, thence northerly through the ne 1/4 of said Section 1 to the sec. 4 of Section 38, Town 32, Range 24, thence northerly through the sec. 4 of said Section 38, into Section 31, Town 32, Range 23, thence in a northerly course through the West half of said Section 31, into the sw 1/4 of sw 1/4 of Section 39, Town 32, Range 23, and terminating at a point in Coon Creek (so called) in the sw 1/4 of sw 1/4 of said Section 39, 40 rods East of the West line of said sw 1/4 of sw 1/4 of said Section 39, to the lowest responsible bidder or bidders, said work to be completed within the time required, and in the manner specified, in said viewer's report. And no bid will be entertained which exceeds more than thirty (30) per cent over and above the estimated cost of the construction, in any case, as stated in the said order; and the successful bidder will be required, to give a satisfactory bond, with two, faithful securities, for the faithful performance and fulfillment of his contract, and to pay all damages that may accrue by reason of his failure to complete the job within the time required in the contract. The said order and estimates and profile are on file, and may be seen at my office.
