Van Elsberg, William Traverse and Fred Wenzel, bearing date the 3rd day of July, 1894, and on file in my office, praying for the establishment of a public ditch along the route proposed therein.

Now, therefore, notice is hereby of the pendency of said petition, and that the same will be heard and determined before the said Board of County Commissioners, at their meeting in regular session at the court house, in the city of Anoka, on the 5th day of January, 1895, at 10 o'clock a. m.

The place of commencement of said ditch at its source is as follows: (Commencing at a near the south east corner of the north east quarter of section 14, town 31, range 23, thence running southerly and through any part of sections 14, 15, 23, 24, 25 and 26 that may be necessary.

The names of the persons through whose lands the proposed ditch passes are as follows: Foster R. Cleman, Fred Wenzel, Mike Flor and Cornelia Linehan.
The place of termination of said ditch at its outlet is as follows: In what is known as Sandy or Golden Lake, in lot 2, in section 25, town 31, range 23, in the northern portion of said lake at or near the northeast corner of said lot 2, to be known as Ditch No. 24.
