AUDITOR'S NOTICE OF PENDENCY OF PETITION.

STATE OF MINNESOTA. } ss.

County of Anoka.

Whereas, the owners of certain lands in the Town of Centerville of said Anoka county, upon the petition of Joseph Tauer, R. Molitor, John Miller, William Speiser and Albert Rehbein bearing date the 25th day of December, 1894, and on file in my office, praying for the establishment of a public ditch along the route proposed therein.

Now, therefore, notice is hereby given of the pendency of said petition, and that the same will be heard and determined before the said Board of County Commissioners, at their meeting in regular session at the Court House, in the city of Anoka, on the 8th day of July, 1895, at 10 o'clock a. m.

The place of commencement of said Ditch at its source is as follows: Commencing at the $\frac{1}{2}$ post next north of the south $\frac{1}{4}$ post of Section 32, Town 31, Range 22, thence running easterly and north easterly through said Section 32, through 33, 25, 21 and 22 in said Town and Range. Also a branch commencing at or near the center of the north west quarter of north west quarter of Sec. 34 of said Town and Range, thence running south westerly and westerly through said sec. 34 and east half of Sec. 33 to connect with main ditch above described in the $\frac{1}{2}$ of said Sec. 33 to be known as Ditch No. 25.
