Now Therefore, Notice is hereby given that the county board of Anoka county will meet at the office of the county auditor of said county on the 25th day of May, 1916 at 2 o'clock p. m., for the purpose of determining the necessity for the repair of said ditch and to apportion and assess the cost thereof, at which time and place all persons interested are required to appear and show cause, if any there be, why such repairs should not be made, and the cost thereof apportioned and assessed to the lands benefited thereby, as by law required.
