 Easterly and North easterly through said section 32, through
 33, 20, 21 and 22 in said Town and Range also a
 Branch commencing at or near the center of the
 North West quarter of North West quarter of sec. 34 of
 said Town of Range, thence running Southwesterly
 and westerly through said sec. 34 and East half of sec.
 33 to connect with main ditch above described
 in the NW 1/4 of said sec. 33 to be known as Ditch No. 25.
