To the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Anoka
State of Minnesota:

The undersigned land owners, whose lands will be liable to be affected by, or assessed for, the expense of the construction of the Ditch

hereinafter described, would respectfully represent that the public health, convenience and welfare, require the establishment and construction of a said ditch will be conducive to the

along the following described route in the Town of Centerville in said County of Anoka of public health, convenience and welfare and the same will be of public benefit and utility and

to-wit: Commencing at the point designated hereby petition and request

the said Board of County Commissioners to cause to be constructed a ditch along the following described route in the Town

of Centerville in said County of Anoka to-wit: commencing at

the 1/2 post next north of the South 1/4 of section Thirty two (32)

and Thirty one (31) Range Twenty two (22); thence running Eastwardly

and Northwardly through said sections Thirty two (32) Thirty three (33)

Thirty eight (38) Twenty one (21) and Twenty two (22) said

Town and Range and terminating in Centerville Lake (so called)

at or near the line between Lots No. 3 and 4 in said section

and terminating at No. Twenty two (22) as its outlet Also a branch

commencing in the center of the North west quarter (NW 1/4)

of sec. Thirty two (32) of said Town and Range; thence running

as its outlet South westerly and westerly through said section No. 34

Thirty four (34) and East half of section Thirty three (33) to

connect with main line above described in the North

half of said section thirty three (33) and at or near the center

of said section thirty three (33)
