~~and request the said Board of County Commissioners to~~ cause to be constructed a ditch along the following described

~~route in the Town of Centerville in said County of Anoka~~ to wit—Commencing at the 1/8 post west north of the south 1/4 post

of Section Thirty two (32) Town Thirty one (31) Range twenty two

(22) Thence running Easterly 3d north easterly through said Section

Thirty two (32) Thirty three (33) Twenty Eight (28) Twenty one (21)

and Twenty two said Town 2d Range 2d terminating in Centerville

Lake (so called) at or near the line between T12 No 3rd 4 in said

Section No. Twenty two (22) as its outlet—~~Also a branch com-~~

mencing in the center of the north west quarter (NW 4) of Sec

Thirty four (34) of said Town 2d Range—Thence running south

as its outlet. Thence westerly through said Section No. Thirty four (34)

and East half of Section thirty three (33) to connect with main

line as described in the north half of said Section thirty three

and near the center of said Section thirty three (33)
