That Joseph Lauer & Wm Speiser and Frank Lauer Rudolph Miller as sureties are held and firmly bound unto the County of Anoka State of Minnesota, in the sum of Two Hundred DOLLARS, lawful money of the United States of America, to be paid to the said County of Anoka State of Minnesota, its successors or assigns, for which payment, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators, firmly by these presents.

Sealed with our seals and dated the 14 day of March one thousand eight hundred and ninety four

The Condition of the Above Obligation is Such, That whereas the above bounden Joseph Lauer, Wm Speiser & others

have filed a petition with the County Auditor of Anoka County, State of Minnesota, praying for the establishment and construction of a public Ditch

along the following described route: Commencing at the 1/2 post near North of the South 1/4 of section Thirty Two (32) and Thirty One (31) Range Twenty Two (22); thence running easterly and North Easterly through said sections Thirty Two (32) Thirty Three (33) Twenty Eight (28) Twenty One (21) and Twenty Two (22) said Town and Range and terminating in Centerville Lake (Escalier) at or near the line between Lots No. 3 and 4 in said section No. Twenty Two (22) in its outlet, also a branch commencing in the center of the North West quarter (NW 1/4) of sec. Thirty Four (34) of said Town and Range; thence running South westerly & westerly through said section No. Thirty Four (34) and East half of section thirty three (33) to connect with main line above described in the North half of said section thirty three and at or near the center of said section thirty three (33)

Now, if the said Joseph Lauer & Wm Speiser and the other Petitioners

shall pay all expenses, in case the Board of County Commissioners of said County shall fail to establish said proposed Ditch then the above obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
