Auditor's Notice of Final Hearing in Ditch Proceedings

In the matter of the petition of Bertha Schmidt and others for Public Ditch No. 72 in the County of Anoka, State of Minnesota.

Notice is hereby given that a petition has been filed in the office of the County Auditor of said County, praying for the construction of a public ditch, designated and numbered by the County Auditor of such County as County Ditch No. 72, commencing 445 feet south of the SE corner of the N 1/2 of NE 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Sec. 13, T. 31, R. 22, thence in a northwesterly direction across the S 1/2 of NE 1/4 of NW 1/4, the N 1/2 of N 1/2 NW 1/4 of Sec. 13, the SW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Sec. 12, and N 1/2 of SE 1/4 of SE 1/4, NE 1/4 of SE 1/4, NW 1/4 of SW 1/4, and into the SW 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Sec. 11, T. 31, R. 22, and there ending at a point 900 feet west and 100 feet north of the SE corner of said SW 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Sec. 11, all in T. 31, R. 22; Branch No. 1: Commencing 290 feet north and 218 feet east of SW corner of N 1/2 of N 1/2 of NW 1/4 of Sec. 13, T. 31, R. 22, thence in a northwesterly direction across the NE 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Sec. 14, and the SE 1/4 of SE 1/4, NE 1/4 of SE 1/4 and NW 1/4 of SE 1/4 of Sec. 11 and there ending in the Main Ditch, all in T. 31, R. 22; Branch No. 2: Commencing 400 feet east and 100 feet south of the NW corner of NE 1/4 of SE 1/4 of Sec. 12, T. 31, R. 22, thence in a southwesterly direction across the NW 1/4 of SE 1/4, SE 1/4 of SW 1/4 and SW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Sec. 12, and there ending in the Main Ditch, all in T. 31, R. 22, together with all other branches and laterals.

And affecting the following described lands: SE 1/4 of Sec. 11; S 1/2 of Sec. 12; NW 1/4 of Sec. 13; N 1/2 of Lot 1 and NE 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Sec. 14, all in T. 31, R. 22. And affecting the following Roads: Centerville Town Road on S line of N 1/2 of SW 1/4 of Sec. 11; Road on East line of N 1/2 of SE 1/4 of SE 1/4, Sec. 11; Road on East line of NE 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Sec. 14, all in T. 31, R. 22. And that the names of the owners of the lands and the names of the municipal and other corporations that will be affected by the construction of said Ditch, as appears in the report of the viewers, hereinafter mentioned, are as follows, to-wit: First National Bank of Forest Lake, Eddie Halley, Edward J. Houle, Helen Houle, Philip J. Houle, Edward Marier, Joseph Pelloquin, Bertha Schmidt, Wiseman A. Sparrow, Town of Centerville.

And the engineer appointed by the County Board of said County to make a survey of the route of said Ditch has completed his work and made due report thereon and filed the same in the office of said County Auditor; and that the viewers appointed by said County Board to view the same have completed their work and filed their report thereof in the office of said County Auditor; and it is further proposed that parts of said Ditch be constructed as a tile Ditch.

And that therefore the County Board of Anoka County, State of Minnesota, will hold a special meeting on Tuesday, the 6th day of February, 1923, at 11 a. m., at the County Auditor's Office in the City of Anoka, for the hearing and consideration of said petition and of said engineer's and viewers' reports thereon, and that all persons interested in the construction of said Ditch are invited to appear and be heard by and before said County Board at said time for or against the construction of said Ditch.
