PETITION FOR PUBLIC DITCH.

To the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Anoka
State of Minnesota:

The undersigned land owners, whose lands will be liable to be affected by, or assessed for, the expense of the construction of the Ditch

hereinafter described, would respectfully represent that the public health, convenience and welfare require the establishment and construction of a the construction of said Ditch will be convenient

along the following described route in the Town of to the public health, convenience and welfare
and the same will be of public benefit and in said County of utility and as the undersigned

to-wit: Commencing at herby petition and request the said Board of County Commissioners to
cause to be constructed Ditch along the following described route in the Towns of
Blaine and Anoka, in said County of Anoka, to-wit: commencing on the 1/2 line
running East & West and 15 rods West of the 1/2 line running North and South in the
SW 1/4 of Sec. 4, Town 31 Range 23; thence westerly through the SW 1/4 of Sec. 4 and
SE 1/4 of Sec. 5; thence south westerly through SW 1/4 of Sec. 5 across the sec. line between
sections 5 & 6; thence westerly thro' NW 1/4 of Sec. 8 and across said sec. line into SE 1/4 of Sec. 7 of said
sec. 5; thence westerly across sec. line between sections 5 & 6; thence westerly through the
SE 1/4 of Sec. 6; thence south westerly thro' SW 1/4 of Sec. 6; thence south on 1/2 line
Sec. 7 about 8 rods; thence South west through the SE 1/4 of Sec. 7; thence West on 1/2 line about
and terminating at 60 rods; thence South & West to the Town line between the Towns of Blaine and
Anoka; thence across said Town line West in sec. 12 Town 31 Range 24 to intersect
Sand Creek, so called; thence down said Creek to a point about 20 rods West of the Bridge
as its outlet across Sand Creek in said sec. 12 as its outlet. Also a Branch commencing
about 25 rods South of the 1/2 line running East & West through the NE 1/4 of
sec. 7 and at sec. line between sections 7 & 8; thence westerly to intersect
the main ditch at or near the center of the NW 1/4 of Sec. 7 in
Town 31 Range 23 as its outlet

And your petitioners pray that you will proceed to establish such Ditch

and cause the same to be constructed as provided by

Chapter 97 General Laws of Minnesota, 1887.
