The Condition of the Above Obligation is Such, That whereas the above bounden
M. J. Pope, J. B. Meister, Henry Lee

have filed a petition with the County Auditor of Anoka County, State
 of Minnesota, praying for the establishment and construction of a public Ditch

along the following described route: commencing on the $\frac{1}{2}$ line running
 East & West and 15 rods West of the $\frac{1}{2}$ line running north and south in the S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec. 4, Town
 31, Range 23, thence westerly through the S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of said sec. 4, and S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec. 5, thence
 south westerly through the S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec. 5 across the sec. line between sections 5 & 8, thence north westerly to the N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of
 sec. 8 and across said sec. line into S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of said sec. 5, thence westerly across sec. line between
 sections 5 & 6, thence westerly through the S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec. 6, thence south westerly
 through S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of said sec. 6, thence south westerly on $\frac{1}{2}$ line of sec. 7 about 80 rods,
 thence south westerly through the S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec. 7, thence west on $\frac{1}{2}$ line
 about 60 rods, thence south and west to the Town line between the Towns
 of Blaine and Anoka, thence across said Town line west in sec. 12
 Town 31, Range 24 to intersect said creek, so called, thence down said
 creek to a point about 20 rods west of the bridge across said creek in
 said sec. 12, and its outlet; also a branch commencing about 25 rods
 south of the $\frac{1}{2}$ line running East & West, through the N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec. 7 and
 at section line between sections 7 & 8, thence westerly to intersect the
 main ditch at or near the center of the N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec. 7 in Town 31, Range
 23, as its outlet.

shall pay all expenses, in case the Board of County Commissioners of said County shall fail to
 establish said proposed Ditch then the above obligation
 to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
