hereinafter described, would respectfully represent that the public health, convenience and welfare

require the establishment and construction of a the construction of said ditch will be conducive

along the following described route in the Town of to the public health, convenience and welfare

and the same will be of public benefit in said County of and utility and in the undersigned,

to-wit: Commencing at the above petition and request the said Board of County Commis-

sioners to cause to be constructed a ditch along the following described route

in the Town of Blaine and Anoka in said County of Anoka, to-wit: com-

mencing on the 1/4 line running East and West and 1/4 rods West of the 1/4 line

running North and South in the SW 1/4 of sec. 4 Town 31 Range 23; thence

westerly through the SW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of said sec. 4 and SE 1/4 of E 1/4 of sec. 5; thence

southwesterly through SW 1/4 of SE 1/4 of sec. 5 across the section line between

sections 5 & 8; thence westerly through NW 1/4 of NW 1/4 sec. 8 and across said sec. line into SE 1/4 of SW 1/4

of said sec. 5; thence westerly across sec. line between sections 5 & 6; thence westerly

through the SE 1/4 of SE 1/4 of sec. 6; thence southwesterly through SW 1/4 of SE 1/4 of said sec. 6; thence

and terminating at southwesterly on 1/4 line of sec. 7 about 80 rods; thence South West through the SW 1/4 of NW 1/4

of sec. 7; thence West on 1/4 line about 60 rods; thence South West to the Town line between

the Towns of Blaine and Anoka; thence across said Town line West in sec. 12 Town 31 Range 24

as its outlet to intersect Sand Creek, so called; thence down said Creek to a point about

20 rods West of the Bridge across Sand Creek in said section 12, as its outlet.

Also a Branch commencing about 25 rods South of the 1/4 line running

East & West through the NE 1/4 of sec. 7 and at section line between sections

7 & 8; thence westerly to intersect the main ditch at or near the center of

the NW 1/4 of sec. 7, in Town 31 Range 23, as its outlet.
