

Sale of Ditching Jobs.

Notice is hereby given, that, on the seventh day of March, 1896, at 11 o'clock a. m., at the office of the County Auditor, in the city of Anoka, county of Anoka and state of Minnesota, I will sell the jobs of digging and constructing the Ditch No. 26 of Anoka county, established by the Board of County Commissioners of Anoka county, state of Minnesota, by their order bearing date January 7th, 1896, viz: In sections of 100 feet each, each of said sections to be known and numbered by stakes, as shown by the report of the viewers in said matter, commencing at the one including the outlet, and from thence, successively, up stream to the one including the source. Said ditch commencing on the $\frac{1}{2}$ line running east and west and 15 rods west of the $\frac{1}{2}$ line running north and south in the $sw\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 4, Town 31, Range 23; thence south and westerly through the $se\frac{1}{4}$ of $sw\frac{1}{4}$ of said Sec. 4, and $se\frac{1}{4}$ of $se\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 5, through Sec. 3 and $se\frac{1}{2}$ of $se\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 6, through $w\frac{1}{2}$ of Sec. 7, all in Town 31, Range 23, through $se\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 12, Town 31, Range 24, and terminating about 20 rods west of the bridge across Sand creek (so called) in said Sec. 12. Also Branch commencing about 25 rods south of the $\frac{1}{2}$ line running east and west through the $ne\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 7, and at Section line between Sections 7 and 8, Town 31, Range 23; thence westerly to intersect the Main Ditch in the $e\frac{1}{2}$ of $nw\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 7, in Town 31, Range 23, as its outlet, to the lowest responsible bidder or bidders, said work to be completed within the time required, and in the manner specified, in said viewer's report. And no bid will be entertained which exceeds more than thirty (30) per cent over and above the estimated cost of construction, in any case, as stated in the said order; and the successful bidder will be required to give a satisfactory bond, with two freehold securities, for the faithful performance and fulfillment of his contract, and to pay all damages that may accrue by reason of his failure to complete the job within the time required in the contract.
