ORDER.

1898

The above entitled cause being regularly on the calendar of the October General Term of the above entitled Court, came duly on for hearing before the same on the 11th day of October, 1898, before a jury, on an appeal by plaintiffs from the final order and judgment of said Board of County Commissioners establishing and laying out a certain ditch and drainage system in said County, known as Ditch No. 27, and otherwise as the "Rathburn Ditch," the appeal being solely on the allowance of damages to and assessment of benefits against said plaintiffs and their lands as described and set forth in their said complaint and appeal papers, and the jury in its verdict on the 12th day of October, 1898, after due trial of the cause, having sustained the action of the said Board of Commissioners in all respects except as to the question of benefits assessed and damages allowed to said plaintiffs, and the jury in its said verdict having found no benefits to the land in question, and having returned a verdict of seventy five dollars damages to said lands, by reason of the construction of said ditch, and judgment having been duly entered in said cause in accordance with said verdict, and said judgment having been duly paid and satisfied,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that said County Ditch and Drainage system be located and established in accordance with the final order and judgment of said Board, as modified by the verdict of said jury, and the judgment in said action, and that the County Auditor shall forthwith proceed to give notice for the letting of the contracts for the construction of said work, as provided by law.
