NOTICE OF PENDENCY AND HEARING ON PETITION, COUNTY OR JUDICIAL DITCH STATE OF MINNESOTA.

County of Anoka, ss. In the Matter of the Petition of R. W. Hunt and Others for the Modification and Improvement of Ditch No. 27 of Anoka County, Minnesota.

WHEREAS, The petition of R. W. Hunt and others, bearing date the 25th day of February, 1948, praying for the improvement and modification of said proposed ditch, has been filed in my office; and WHEREAS, The Engineer and Viewers duly appeared in said proceedings and the Director have all filed their reports in my office as provided by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, Notice is hereby given of the pendency of said petition, and that the same will be heard and considered before the Board of County Commissioners of Anoka County at the Court House in the City of Anoka in said County, on the 22nd day of August, 1949, at 2 o'clock P.M. All persons interested in the modification and improvement of said proposed ditch are invited to appear and be heard at said time.

A general description of the proposed starting point, route and terminus of said ditch, as stated in the petition or subsequently amended on the recommendation of the Engineer, is as follows, to-wit:

Commencing on the line between the North East quarter and the Southeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section thirty-three (33), at a point on said line about ten (10) rods east of the West line of said two forties as its starting point; thence running along the following route: Southeasterly on and across the Southeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of said section thirty-two (32), and thence on to and across a portion of the Southwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section thirty-three (33), thence on to and across a portion of the Northwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of section thirty-three (33), thence onto and across a portion of the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section thirty-two (32), thence onto and across the south half of the Southeast quarter of Section thirty-two (32), thence on the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of Section thirty-two (32), to the highway; all in township thirty-three (33), range twenty-five (25), Anoka County, Minnesota; thence across said highway and onto and across the Northeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section five (5), thence onto the Southeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section five (5), thence onto and across the South half of the Northeast quarter of section five (5), thence onto and across the Southwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section four (4), thence onto and across a portion of the Southeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section four (4), thence onto and across a portion of the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section four (4), thence onto and across the north half of the Northeast quarter of Section four (4), thence onto and across a portion of the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section three (3), thence onto and across a portion of the Southwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section three (3), thence onto and across the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section three (3), thence onto and across a portion of the Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section ten (10), and there terminating in Trott Brook at a point about rods from the west line of the Northeast quarter of said Section ten (10); all in Township thirty-three (33), Range twenty-five (25), Anoka County, Minnesota.
