Whereas, The owners of certain lands in the Town of Ramsey and Burns of said Anoka County,

Herring, bearing date the 8th day of Sept., 1887, and on file in my office, praying for the establishment of a public Ditch along the route proposed therein,

Now, Therefore, Notice is hereby given of the pendency of said petition, and that the same will be heard and determined before the said Board of County Commissioners, at their meeting in special regular session at the Court House in the City of Anoka on the Twelfth day of March, 1888, at 10 o'clock A.M.

The place of commencement of said Ditch at its source is as follows:

Commencing about 20 rods North of the South East corner of S 1/4 of S E 1/4 Section 19 Town 33 Range 25; thence through N E 1/4 N E 1/4 Sec. 30; thence South Easterly through Sec 29 + 32 Town 33 Range 25; thence through N W 1/4 Sec 5 Town 32 Range 25 (through sections 6, 4 and 3 Town 32 Range 25) and terminates in Trott Brook (so called) in sec 3; with such Branches as may be necessary
