Whereas, A petition bearing date the 9th day of September 1887, signed by Geo. L. Parkton, P. Dickerson, J. C. Overkerson, W. P. Papprecht, Carl von S. Miller, Charles Knack, Peter Dan, C. F. Holm, C. J. Peterson, P. Tolson, J. J. Berken, John Weigand, M. Herrarst, J. J. Toraman, J. H. Keen, John Moss, M. Merian, Walter Heller, J. A. Cervind praying for the establishment of a certain Ditch in said County, the route of which is more fully described in said petition, and a proper bond accompanying the same, have been filed with the County Auditor of said County, as by law required;

And Whereas, It appears, by satisfactory proof to the Board of County Commissioners of Anoka County, that at least thirty (30) days' notice of the pendency of said petition, and the time and place at which the same would be heard, has been given as required by law;

And Whereas, Said Board has determined that the construction of such ditch as proposed in said petition will be of public benefit or utility, or conducive to the public health, convenience or welfare;

Now, Therefore, We, the Board of County Commissioners of said County, at a Special regular session held this day, do hereby accept said petition, do hereby appoint Thomas B. Preston, V. at Lyons, or John Hunter three resident freeholders of said County, and not interested in the construction of said proposed work, and not of kin to any parties interested therein, as viewers, and do specify the 6th day of November 1887, at the County Auditor's Office in the City of Anoka at 1 o'clock P. M. as the time and place for said viewers to meet, preparatory to commencing their duties as such viewers, as prescribed by law, and after completing their duties as such viewers to make and file their report with the County Auditor of said County, on or before the 24th day of December 1887.
