The undersigned land owners, whose lands will be liable to be affected by, or assessed for, the expense of the construction of the Public Ditch hereinafter described, would respectfully represent that the ~~public health, convenience and welfare~~ require the establishment and construction of a Public Ditch

along the following described route in the Town of _____ of _____ will be conducive to the public health, convenience and welfare and the ~~public health, convenience and welfare~~ of _____ in said County of Anoka and the ~~public health, convenience and welfare~~ of _____ to-wit: Commencing at _____ will be a public benefit and utility and we the undersigned hereby petition and request the said Board of County Commissioners to cause to be constructed a Ditch along the following described route in the towns of Burns and Ramsay in said County of Anoka to-wit-

Commencing about 20 rods North of South East corner of SO¹ of SO¹ Section-19-Town-33-Range-25 thence through NO¹ of NO¹ Section-30 thence South Westerly through Sec. 29 of 32-Town-33-Range-25 thence and terminating at through NW¹ Section-5-Town-32-Range-25 through Sections-5-4-3-Town-32-Range-25 and terminate in Spott Brook, so called in Section-3-10 as its outlet with such Branches as may be necessary.

And your petitioners pray that you will proceed to establish such Public Ditch and cause the same to be constructed as provided by

Chapter 97 General Laws of Minnesota, 1887. and all amendments thereto.
