The place of commencement of said ditch at its source is as follows: Commencing about 20 rods North of South East corner of se 1/4 of se 1/4, section 19, Town 33, Range 25; thence through ne 1/4 of ne 1/4, section 30, thence south easterly through sections 29 and 32, Town 33, Range 25; thence through nw 1/4, section 3, Town 32, Range 25, through sections 5, 4, and 3, Town 32, Range 25 and terminate in Troit Brook (so called) in section 3, with such branches as may be necessary.
