SALE OF DITCHING JOBS.

Notice is Hereby Given, That, on the 2nd day of July 1885, at 10 o'clock A. M., at the County Auditor's Office in the City of Anoka, County of Anoka and State of Minnesota I will sell the jobs of digging and constructing the Ditch No. 28 of Anoka County, established by the Board of County Commissioners of Anoka County, State of Minnesota, by their order bearing date May 3rd, 1885, viz.:
 In sections of 100 feet each, each of said sections to be known and numbered by stakes, as shown by the report of the viewers in said matter, commencing at the one including the outlet, and from thence, successively, up stream to the one including the source Main line of said ditch commences near center of sec. 5 T. 32 R. 23 thence in a general northerly direction thro' said sec. 5 ^{and through sec. 29} T. 33 R. 23 and terminating in Crooked Brook near center of said sec. 29
Branch No. 0 comm. NW 1/4 of sec. 4 T. 32 R. 23 th. runs northwesterly to Branch No. 1 and there terminates in NW 1/4 sec. 4. Branch No. 1 comm. NE 1/4 sec. 4 T. 32 R. 23 th. runs in a general westerly direction thro' sec. 4 and NE 1/4 sec. 5 to Main Ditch about 50 yds N. of center of sec. 5 and there terminates. Branch No. 2 comm. in SW 1/4 of sec. 33 T. 33 R. 23 th. in a general westerly direction thro' SW 1/4 sec. 33 and SE 1/4 sec. 32 and terminating in Main Ditch in SW 1/4 sec. 32 T. 33 R. 23. Branch No. 3 comm. in NW 1/4 of sec. 4 T. 32 R. 23 th. in a general northwesterly direction thro' sec. 33 T. 33 R. 23 and SE 1/4 sec. 32 to Main Ditch in SW 1/4 sec. 32 T. 33 R. 23 and there terminating. Branch No. 4 comm. in NW 1/4 of sec. 33 T. 33 R. 23 th. runs northwesterly to Branch No. 3 in SW 1/4 said sec. 33 and there terminates. Branch No. 5 comm. in NW 1/4 sec. 5 T. 32 R. 23 th. runs northwesterly to Main Ditch in SE 1/4 sec. 5 said sec. 5
Branch No. 6 comm. in NE 1/4 NW 1/4 sec. 5 T. 32 R. 23 th. runs N. easterly and S. easterly to Main Ditch in NE 1/4 said sec. 5. Branch No. 7 comm. in NW 1/4 sec. 32 T. 33 R. 23 th. easterly to Main Ditch in SW 1/4 sec. 32 T. 33 R. 23 and there terminating
 to the lowest responsible bidder or bidders, said work to be completed within the time required, and in the manner specified, in said viewer's report. And no bid will be entertained which exceeds more than thirty (30) per cent over and above the estimated cost of the construction, in any case, as stated in the said order; and the successful bidder will be required to give a satisfactory bond, with two freehold securities, for the faithful performance and fulfillment of his contract, and to pay all damages that may accrue by reason of his failure to complete the job within the time required in the contract.
