PETITION FOR PUBLIC DITCH.

To the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Anoka
State of Minnesota:

The undersigned land owners, whose lands will be liable to be affected by, or assessed for, the expense of the construction of the Public Ditch, hereinafter described, would respectfully represent that the ~~public health, convenience and welfare~~ require the establishment and construction of a Public Ditch

along the following described route in the Town of _____ of _____ will be conducive to the Public health, convenience in said County of _____ and welfare and the to-wit: Commencing at same will be of public benefit and utility and we the undersigned hereby petition and request the said Board of County Commissioners to cause to be constructed a Ditch along the following described route in the Towns of Bethel and Ham Lake in said County of Anoka - to-wit: -

Commencing about 20 rods East of the center of Section 5 Town 32 Range 23 and thence in a generally northerly direction through said Section 5 and Sections 22 and 29 Town 33 Range 23 to Crooked Brook (so called) and terminating at said Crooked Brook near the center of said Section 29 as its outlet, with such Branch Ditch or Ditches as the viewers may deem necessary to give the ~~as its outlet~~ lands assessed for the construction of said Ditch the full benefit thereof.

And your petitioners pray that you will proceed to establish such Public Ditch and cause the same to be constructed as provided by

Chapter 97 General Laws of Minnesota, 1887. and all amendments thereto.
