A general description of the proposed starting point, route and terminus of said ditch is as follows

Commencing about 20 rods East of the center of Section 5 Town 32 Range 23 and thence in a generally Northernly direction through said Section 5 and Sections 32 and 29 Town 33 Range 23 to Crooked Brook (so called) and terminating at said Crooked Brook near the center of said Section 29 as it is out let, with such Branch Ditch or Ditches as the Viewers may deem necessary to give the lands assessed for the construction of said Ditch the full benefit thereof.
