KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That We, Edward
Anderson and J.W. Johnson
as principals, and Freedolph Vanstrum and Adolph Anderson, as sureties,
are held and firmly bound unto the County of Anoka in the State of Minnesota,
in the sum of Two Thousand (\$2000.00) Dollars, lawful money of
the United States of America, to be paid to the said County of Anoka,
State of Minnesota, its successors or assigns, for which payment, well
and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, successors,
administrators and assigns, firmly by those presents.

THE CONDITION OF THIS OBLIGATION IS SUCH, That Whereas, the above
bounden Edward Anderson & J.W. Johnson
and others, have filed a petition with the County Auditor of Anoka County,
State of Minnesota, praying for the establishment and construction of
repairs of County Ditch Number Twenty-eight (28) of said County, and for
the opening, widening, deepening, straightening and repairing of the same;

NOW THEREFORE, if the said Edward Anderson & J.W. Johnson
shall pay to the County all costs and expenses which may be incurred in
case the proceedings are for any reason dismissed or said proposed
repairs are not finally ordered or established, or for any reason no
contract is entered into for the said repairs, then this obligation
shall be void; otherwise to remain in full force and effect.
