Now therefore, notice is hereby given of the pendency of said petition, and that the same will be heard and determined before the said board of county commissioners at their special session at the court house in the city of Anoka on the 2nd day of May, 1898, at 10 o'clock a. m.

The place of commencement of said ditch at its source is as follows: Com. at the nw cor. of the sw 1/4 of the ne 1/4 of Sec. 6, T. 32, R. 23; th. running in a northwesterly course thro' said Sec. six (6) to the east line of Sec. 1 in T. 32, R. 24, thence westerly thro' the north half of said Sec. 1 to the east line of Sec. 2 in said town 32, range 24; thence southwesterly thro' said Sec. 2 to a point on the west line of said Sec. 2, where Clark's Brook, so called, crosses said Sec. line; thence down Clark's Brook in a northwesterly course thro' the se 1/4 of Sec. 3 in Township 32, Range 24 and terminating at the point where said Clark's Brook crosses the north line of the said se 1/4 of said Sec. and being duly sworn, deposes and says, that he now is and during all the time hereinafter mentioned has been the manager and printer of *The Anoka Herald*, a weekly newspaper printed and published in the City of Anoka, in said Anoka County, on Friday of each week.
