through and sec. 6. to the east line of sec. 1, Town 32 Range 24.

thence northerly through the N. 1/4 of said sec. 1, to the east line of sec. 2
thence southerly through said sec. 1 to
the corner 32 Range 24, a point on the west line of said sec. 2

where Black's Brook is called, crosses said sec. line. thence down
Black's Brook in a north westerly course through the east cor-
ner of sec. 3 in Town 32 Range 24 and terminating at the point where said

Black's Brook crosses the north line of the said 8. 1/4 Sec. 3 on its outlet with
such a bend with a depth of the water may seem necessary against the current
for the convenience of said said bridge crossing
