AUDITORS NOTICE OF PENDENCY

OF PETITION.

STATE OF MINNESOTA, COUNTY OF ANOKA, ss.—

Whereas, the owners of certain lands in the town of Ham Lake and grow of said Anoka county, upon the petition of Ole Peterson, A. E. Strongren, M. G. Day, Hudson Gray, F. Rahn-drick, Hans Hanson, P. W. Jepserson, bearing date the 29th day of Nov., 1897, and on file in my office, praying for the establishment of a public ditch along the route proposed therein.

Now therefore, notice is hereby given of the pendency of said petition, and that the same will be heard and determined before the said board of county commissioners at their special session at the court house in the city of Anoka on the 2nd day of May, 1898, at 10 o'clock a. m.

The place of commencement of said ditch at its source is as follows: Com. at the nw cor. of the SW 1/4 of the 104 of Sec. 6, T. 52, R. 23, th. running in a northwesterly course thro' said Sec. six (6) to the east line of Sec. 1 in T. 52, R. 24, thence westerly thro' the north half of said Sec. 1 to the east line of Sec. 2 in said town 52, range 24; thence southwesterly thro' said Sec. 2 to a point on the west line of said Sec. 2 where Clark's Brook, so called, crosses said Sec. line; thence thro' Clark's Brook in a northwesterly course and terminating at the point where said Clark's Brook crosses the north line of the said SW 1/4 of said Sec. three, as its outlet, with such branch ditch or ditches as the viewers may deem necessary to drive the lands assessed for the construction of said ditch to the full benefit thereof.
