Whereas, The viewers appointed by the Board of County Commissioners of said County of Lutsa at their session held on the 12th day of March, 1891, upon the petition of James McDonald, Andrew Mattson, John T. McDonald and others, bearing date the 24th day of Jan, 1891, and on file in my office, praying for the establishment of a public Ditch along the route proposed therein, have made their report and filed the same in my office.

Now, therefore, Notice is hereby given of the pendency of said petition, and that the same will be heard and determined before the said Board of County Commissioners, at their session to be held at Cozyville in the City of Lutsa in said County, on the 11th day of July, 1891, at 11 o'clock A. M.

The place of commencement of said Ditch at its source is as follows:
From about thirity (30) rods east of the center of the NW 1/4 of sec 1, Twp 33 Range 25; thence in general northwesterly direction through the NW 1/4 and the SW 1/4 of Sec 30 Range 25 and Sec 28 R 25 Sec 35 - said town and range to Sec 28 R 25 Sec 35 called as the outlet. Also a Grand conducing about North E of the N.E. corner of the NW 1/4 of Sec 2 Twp 33 Range 25 thence southwesterly about 45 rods thence N. E. thence NW 1/4 Sec 27 33 R 25 and SE 1/4 Sec 25 33 R 25 - to Marie Ritten
