SALE OF DITCHING JOBS.

Notice is hereby given, That, on the 10 day of September 1898, at 10 o'clock A. M., at the County Auditor's Office in the City of Ancona.

I will sell the jobs of digging and constructing the Ditch No. 30 of Ancona County, established by the Board of County Commissioners of Ancona County, State of Minnesota, by their order bearing date July 11 1898, viz.:

In sections of 100 feet each, each of said sections to be known and numbered by stakes, as shown by the report of the viewers in said matter, commencing at the one including the outlet, and from thence, successively, up stream to the one including the source

The main line of said ditch commences about thirty (30) rods East of the center of the 3rd 1/2nd of Sec. 1. Thence 33 Ranges 25th. Thence in a general north-westerly direction through the 2nd 1/2nd of said Sec. 1 and the 1st 1/2nd of Sec. 36 and E 1/2nd of Sec. 36th Town 34 Range 25 to Sledge Brook (so called) on its outlet. Also a Branch commencing about ten rods East of the N.E. Corner of the 2nd 1/2nd of Sec. 2 1/2nd R. 25. Thence South Easterly about 45 rods. Thence N. Easterly thro' the 2nd 1/2nd of Sec. 1 of Sec. 2 1/2nd R. 25 and S. E. 1/4th of Sec. 35. Thence S. Easterly thro' the 1st 1/2nd of Sec. 35 to the outlet.

to the lowest responsible bidder or bidders, said work to be completed within the time required, and in the manner specified, in said viewer's report. And no bid will be entertained which exceeds more than thirty (30) per cent over and above the estimated cost of the construction, in any case, as stated in the said order; and the successful bidder will be required to give a satisfactory bond, with two freehold securities, for the faithful performance and fulfillment of his contract, and to pay all damages that may accrue by reason of his failure to complete the job within the time required in the contract. The said order and estimates and profile are on file, and may be seen at my office.
