Also commencing at the starting point of Ditch in Dec 1 Town 32 Range 22, thence running in a general Southly direction through section 1-12-11 and 14 terminating in Spring Lake so called in Dec 14 Town 32 Range 22

Also a Branch Ditch beginning in the middle of Dec 1 Town 32 Range 22, thence running South westerly through section 1-2-11 and 14 terminating in Spring Lake in Dec 14 said Town and Range; with such other branches as the wisdom may deem necessary to give the lands covered for the construction of said Ditch, the full benefit there of.
