SALE OF DITCHING JOBS.

Notice is hereby given, That, on the 10th day of September 1898, at one o'clock P.M., at County Auditor's Office in the City of Aurora

I will sell the jobs of digging and constructing the Ditch No. 31 of Aurora County, established by the Board of County Commissioners of Aurora County,

State of Minnesota, by their order bearing date July 14 1898, viz.:

Also Branch 20.1 Com. in main line South about 25 rods by its starting point thence in a general S. westerly direction thro' N. 1/2 of S. 1/2 of S. 1/2 of S. 1/2 Dec. 2. N. E. 1/2 of S. 1/2 Dec. 12 all in Town 32 R. 22. Also Branch No. 3 Com. at N. corner of N. 1/2 of S. 1/2 Dec. 1. S. 32 R. 22. Thence in a S. easterly direction to Branch No. 1 in N. 1/2 of S. 1/2 of S. 1/2 said Dec. 1, to the lowest responsible bidder or bidders, said work to be completed within the time required, and in the manner specified, in said viewer's report. And no bid will be entertained which exceeds more than thirty (30) per cent over and above the estimated cost of the construction, in any case, as stated in the said order; and the successful bidder will be required to give a satisfactory bond, with two freehold securities, for the faithful performance and fulfillment of his contract, and to pay all damages that may accrue by reason of his failure to complete the job within the time required in the contract.
