And Guthrie, At a public sale of the jobs of digging and constructing the entire, work in linear sections of 100 feet each, each of which sections is marked and known and numbered by the stake set by said viewers at the foot of each of said sections, as shown by the viewers' report, commencing at the one including the outlet, and thence, in succession, to the one including the source, held Oct. 1, 1889, the said G. P. Woodworth County Auditor as aforesaid, did duly sell to the said E. P.
