


IN THE MATTER OF THE PETITION OF MICHAEL GALLAGHER AND OTHERS FOR THE REPAIR OF
COUNTY DITCH NUMBER THIRTY-TWO, OF ANOKA COUNTY, MINNESOTA:

WHEREAS, A petition has been filed bearing date the 20th day of November, 1914, praying for the repair of County Ditch No. 32, of Anoka County, together with a proper bond accompanying the same, and said petition has been heard and considered by the Board of County Commissioners of said Anoka County at its meeting held on the 21st day of December, 1914, pursuant to notice of said hearing duly published and posted as by law required, and the said Board of County Commissioners has appointed a competent civil engineer, to-wit: Wayne L. Ridge, to make a complete survey of said ditch and to estimate the cost of such repairs, and who has on the 31st day of August, 1915, filed his said report, and the said Board of County Commissioners has appointed John Hunter, B. H. Titterud and Ivan Anderson to be viewers of said proposed repairs by their order filed in my office the 31st day of August, 1915,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, That said viewers be and meet at the auditor's office in the city of Anoka, in said County, on Saturday, the 4th day of September, A. D. 1915, at ten o'clock A. M., preparatory to assuming and commencing their duties as such viewers, said time being within fifteen days after the filing of the engineer's report of his survey in said matter.
