

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Daniel Peebles, as principal
and R. A. W. Deane and E. J. Gunderwald, as sureties, each
and all of whom are resident freeholders of Anoka County, Minnesota,
are held and firmly bound unto the County Board of Anoka County, Minnesota,
in the sum of Two Hundred and Fifty (\$250.00) Dollars, lawful money of
the United States of America, to be paid to the said County Board of Anoka
County, Minnesota, its successors or assigns, for which payment, well and
truly to be made, we bind ourselves and each of our heirs, executors and
administrators, firmly by these presents.

THE CONDITION OF THE ABOVE OBLIGATION IS SUCH, That Whereas, Daniel
Peebles, who is the owner and entitled to the possession of the following
described lands and premises in Anoka County, Minnesota, to-wit:- The
Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4) of the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4) of Section
Seven (7), in Township Thirty-one (31) and Range Twenty-two (22); The
Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4) of the Northeast Quarter (NE 1/4), the
Northeast Quarter (NE 1/4) of the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4), the
Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4) of the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4), the
Section One (1), and the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4) of the Northwest
Quarter (NW 1/4) of Section Thirteen (13), all in Township Thirty-one
(31) and Range Twenty-three (23), deeming himself aggrieved and being in
fact aggrieved, as to each of said tracts, by the order of the County
Board of Anoka County, Minnesota, in the above entitled matter, made and
dated on the 26th day of October, A.D. 1915, and filed in the office of
the County Auditor of Anoka County, Minnesota, in and by the terms of
which said order the amount of the benefits and damages to the above
described tracts of land, and each of them, was fixed and determined as in
said order described, has appealed from said order so fixing and determining
