## AUDITOR'S NOTICE OF PENDING OF PETITION.

(First publication August 10th, 1898.)

Whereas, the viewers appointed by the Board of County Commissioners of said County of Anoka, at their session held on the 3rd day of May, 1898, upon the petition of Daniel Feebles, John Dyane, F. S. Clement, S. W. Shafter, C. F. Behne and others, bearing date the 6th day of January, 1898, and on file in my office praying for the establishment of a public ditch along the route proposed therein, have made their report and filed the same in my office, said ditch to be numbered 32.

Now, therefore, notice is hereby given of the pendency of said petition, and that the same will be heard and determined before the said Board of County Commissioners, at their session to be held at the Court House, in the City of Anoka, in said County, on the 3rd day of September, 1898, at 10 o'clock a. m.

The place of commencement of said ditch at its source is as follows: MAIN LINE.
